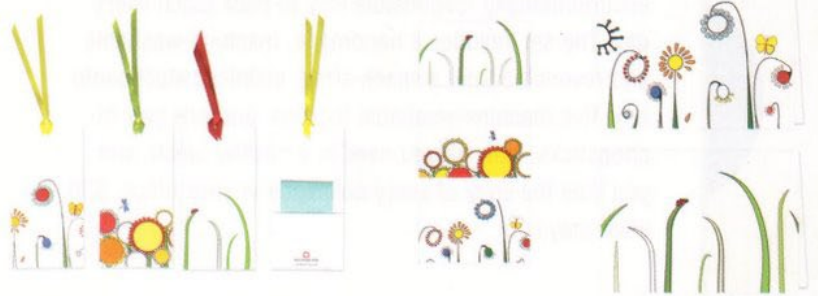


# Red Bird Ink
